Choosing the right paper for the perfect photograph means the difference between a good print and a great one. That is why I chose to print on pro grade photo paper manufactured by Kodak. You can select from the four types of paper that are described below. Each paper is unique in its feel and look, when viewed under right light it can be a joy to watch.

Kodak Professional Supra Endura VC Digital Paper (**Matte/Gloss**) is the most popular paper used by professional photographers because it produces some of the best color, realistic saturation, excellent neutral flesh reproduction and greater intensity.

Endura **Metallic** uses a patented combination of film and laminate layers resulting in striking three-dimensional images. Its unique pearlescent surface, resistance to tearing and curling, and ultra-bright backgrounds make it an exceptional paper regardless of application.

Fine Art Prints are printed with large format inkjet printers on Fine Art Paper. Fine Art paper is similar in look and feel to watercolor paper, and is a great alternative for fiber-based printing.

All papers mentioned above have an archival value of 100 years in home display and 200 years in dark storage.
